This Grade 5-8 lesson called "No Vehicles in the Park" is supported by the MN Academic Standards for Social Studies, specifically the citizenship and government benchmarks. This lesson shows how a local government ordinance can solve a community problem, but when the law is enforced, it creates new problems that may need a better law.

Please note that this lesson has opportunities for accountability: (1) students draw a park, (2) complete a chart following the cases on the slides and (3) are asked to tell someone about other ways to solve the problem.
